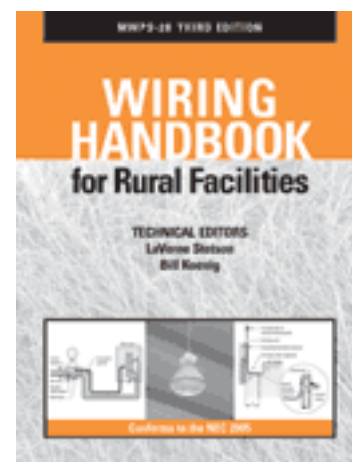

Wiring Handbook for Rural Facilities

AMES, IOWA - *Wiring Handbook for Rural Facilities* (MWPS-28) is now available from MWPS (MidWest Plan Service), at Iowa State University. The book is 96-pages, 8½ x 11, and generously illustrated. Cost is \$20.00 plus shipping and handling.

Wiring Handbook for Rural Facilities replaces *Farm Buildings Wiring Handbook*, which sold more than 15,000 copies in earlier editions. The handbook shows and explains materials and methods for assessing and installing electrical wiring in agricultural-type buildings and equipment.

Completely revised, reorganized, and updated, *Wiring Handbook for Rural Facilities* reflects the 2005 National Electric Code (NEC) and the current American Society of Agriculture and Biological Engineers (ASABE) Standards. It features dozens of revised and new photographs, illustrations, tables, and examples that supplement explanations. Also included are new facts about lighting plus expanded coverage of stray voltage and electrical safety around grain bins.

Chapters cover electrical design and component basics, branch circuits, service entrance, standby power, alarm systems, stray voltage, and lightning protection. Example buildings provide guides for designing an entire electrical system for specific needs.
